ENROLMENT POLICY

The following items constitute the basic requirements set forth by the School Board for parents who wish to enroll their children in Immanuel Christian Schools.

Parents must agree with the objectives of the school as set forth in the Constitution.

Parents must actively support and promote the objectives of Immanuel Christian Schools.

Parents must be committed Christians and be able to verbalize what Jesus Christ means to them in terms of the Christian life.

Parents must be active and supportive members of a Christian Church.

Exceptions can be made to the above point for single parent families or where only one parent is a committed Christian.

Parents should be able to articulate their objectives in education from a Christian perspective and must be willing to learn more about the objectives of Christian Education via readings and seminars.

Parents must give evidence of a supportive Christian home where children are led and taught via daily Bible devotions and prayer.

Parents cannot be members of, or involved in, any Cult or Sect whose teaching is contrary to the Scriptures.

Parents of prospective children will be interviewed by a Committee of the Board after the appropriate registration form has been received.

Mature High School students, who are professing Christians, may be accepted on their own profession even if their parents are not Christians themselves. The parents must be in agreement with their children being enrolled.

The decision to accept or reject enrolment rests with the Board as a whole.
